Hello. This is the starters listening test. Skills practice one.

# *R* Look at part one. Now look at the picture. Listen and look. There is one example.

- **G** Hi! Here is a photo of my friends. We are playing in the park near our school.
- M Oh yes! Who's that? The boy on the bike? He is waving.
- **G** He is my brother. His name is Bill. He is waving hello to our mother!
- **R** Can you see the line? This is an example. Now you listen and draw lines.
- **R** One
  - *M* I can see a girl here. She is eating an apple. What is her name?
  - **G** That is Alice. She is my friend. She loves fruit.
  - **M** Oh yes... Alice is sitting under the tree and eating an apple.
- **R** Two
  - **G** Can you see Dan? He is my cousin. He is singing.
  - **M** Dan? Where is he?
  - **G** He is standing between the two dogs. Dan loves singing and he loves dogs.
  - *M* Yes, Dan looks happy singing to the dogs!
- **R** Three

- **M** Look at the girl. She is running. She is playing football.
- **G** That is Kim. She loves football. She is very good at sports.
- M Oh! Can Kim play hockey too?
- **G** No, she plays football and baseball.
- M Wow!
- **R** Four
  - **G** Can you see the two frogs?
  - **M** Where? Where are the two frogs?
  - **G** The two frogs are near the tree. My friend Mark is playing with the frogs.
  - *M* Yes I see. Frogs are funny. Does Mark like frogs?
  - **G** Yes, he does!
- **R** Five
  - **M** And who is that girl? She is in the red t-shirt and she is holding an ice cream.
  - **G** That is Grace. She loves ice cream on sunny days!
  - **M** I see. Grace is eating an ice cream to cool down in the afternoon.
  - **G** Yes....see you!
- **R** Now listen to Part One again. That is the end of part one.

#### Part two. Look at the picture. Listen and look. There are two examples.

- **M** Hello, are you the girl in this picture?
- **G** Yes, my name is Sue.
- **M** And how do you spell that?
- **G** S-U-E.
- M And how old are you Sue?
- G I'm ten.
- M Ten?
- G Yes!
- **R** Can you see the answers? Now you Listen and write a name or a number.

# **R** One

- **M** Is this your duck in the picture with you?
- **G** Yes it is.
- **M** And what is its name?
- **G** Its name is Lucy.
- M That is a great name for a duck. How do you spell that?
- **G** L-U-C-Y.

# **R** Two

- **M** Sue, how old is Lucy?
- **G** She's four years old.
- **M** Oh, four years old!
- **R** Three
  - **M** Is this your friend in the picture with you?
  - **G** Yes, it is!
  - M What's his name?
  - **G** His name's Tony.
  - **M** How do you spell that?
  - **G** T-O-N-Y.
- **R** Four
  - **M** Is he in your class at school?
  - **G** Yes. We're in class four.
  - M Pardon?
  - **G** We're in class four.
- **R** Five
  - **M** And has Tony got any animals?
  - **G** Yes. He has got some cats.
  - M Cats? How many?
  - **G** He's got two.
  - **M** That's great. Two cats. Thank you Sue.
- **R** Now listen to Part Two again. That is the end of Part Two.

# Part three. Look at the pictures. Now listen and look. There is one example.

- **R** Which is dad's motorbike?
  - **B** Is that black motorbike your dad's?
  - **G** No, it's grandfathers.
  - **B** Is your dad's motorbike red?
  - **G** No, the red motorbike is Bill's. Dad's motorbike is green.
- **R** Can you see the tick? Now you listen and tick the box.

- **R** One. What is Tom doing?
  - **W** Is Tom playing basketball in the garden?
  - **B** No, he isn't.
  - **W** Has he got a football?
  - **B** No he hasn't. Tom is painting in the garden.
- **R** Two. Where are mum and dad?
  - **G** Are mum and dad watching television in the living room?
  - **B** No they aren't. They are in the kitchen.
  - **G** Are they eating?
  - **B** No, they are having a drink.
- **R** Three. What is grandfather doing?
  - ₩ I can't find grandfather. Is he in the kitchen?
  - **G** No. He's sitting in the garden.
  - **W** Is he sleeping?
  - **G** No, he isn't. He's reading a book.
- **R** Four. Who's Ann with?
  - **G** Is Ann in her bedroom?
  - **G** No, she isn't. She's at school.
  - **G** Is she with her friend Sue?
  - **G** No. She is with her teacher Miss Kim.
- **R** Five. Which woman is grandmother?
  - **M** Is grandmother wearing a dress?
  - **B** Yes, she is. She is wearing a purple dress.
  - **M** Oh, has she got a handbag?
  - **B** Yes. Her handbag is pink.
- **R** Now listen to Part Three again. That is the end of Part Three.

# Part Four. Look at the picture. Listen and look. There is one example.

- ${\boldsymbol W}$  Find the mouse under the chair.
- **B** Sorry? Which mouse?
- **W** The mouse under the chair. Colour it green.
- **B** Green?
- W Yes.
- **R** Can you see the green mouse? This is an example. Now you listen and colour.



### **R** One

- **W** Do you see the mouse in front of the armchair?
- **B** In front of the armchair?
- ₩ Yes. Please color it grey.
- **B** Right. The mouse in front of the armchair is grey.
- **R** Two
  - **W** Can you find the mouse behind the cupboard?
  - **B** Find the mouse where?
  - **W** Behind the cupboard. Colour it orange.
  - **B** That's silly! An orange mouse?
  - W Yes.
- **R** Three
  - ✔ Can you see the mouse between the two chairs?
  - **B** Where?
  - **W** Between the two chairs. Colour it brown.
  - **B** Cool. A brown mouse.

- **R** Four
  - $\pmb{W}~$  Find the mouse on the armchair.
  - **B** The mouse on the armchair?
  - ₩ Yes. Now colour it black.
  - **B** Oh yes, I see it. It is sleeping!
- **R** Five
  - ₩ There's a mouse on the phone. Do you see it?
  - **B** Sorry?
  - **W** The mouse on the phone. Colour it blue.
  - **B** A blue mouse?
  - W Yes!
- **R** Now listen to Part Four again.
