Ingredients

- 100 g butter (soft)
- 50 g sugar
- 1 egg
- 120 g plain flour
- 30 g cocoa powder
- ½ teaspoon baking powder
- A pinch of salt
- Icing sugar/ dried coconut (for coating)

A. Shape the dough into small balls and put them on a baking tray with paper.	_____
B. Roll the warm cookies in icing sugar or dried coconut so they look like snowballs.	_____
C. Mix the butter and sugar in a bowl until soft and creamy.	_____
D. Add the egg and mix well.	_____
E. Bake in a hot oven (180°C) for 10 - 20 minutes.	_____
F. Add the flour, cocoa powder, baking powder, and salt. Mix to make a dough.	_____
